- 3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES
Moved by Cyndy Jankowski to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on January 9, 2024. Seconded by Beth Santer. Motion passed.

- 4. PROGRAM REPORT: AMY PREVO
 - Prevo: Wellness Wednesdays kicked off.
 - Prevo: Met with Officer Lindberg, Security Resource Administrator for Northville City.
 - Sondreal: Met with elementary school principals. Starting to reach into the elementary schools as the number of in case management referrals at the elementary level has increased. Goal is to reach kids early and build a good foundation. Numbers are high but have plateaued.
 - Sondreal: Ability to access to case workers has become much easier. Enough staff are in place right now
 - Prevo: Gabrielle Duhn expressed interest in a program associated with leadership and the skate park
 - Prevo: January report shows uptick in vaping
 - Kelly: Asked about process time. 13 kids are in process
 - Sondreal: Kids in Trouble / diversion range from 4 weeks to 2 months, Case Management is different. A few weeks to a couple months with defined re-entry plans and threat assessments
 - Kelly: How are case closures communicated? What if student moves out of state...? A certificate is portable and can be kept with the student

- 5. FINANCIAL REPORT: AMY PREVO
 - Prevo: 1 month in. 2.8% of budget spent so far
 - Prevo: Discussions with CWW on increasing budget from \$10,000 / year

- 6. LIASION REPORTS
 - Northville Township – Cyndy Jankowski
 - Cross country team recognized for state championship
 - Todd Muchler recognized for all his contributions
 - Paul Slayton recognized as Township Volunteer of the Year
 - Traci Sincock recognized as Citizen of the Year

 - Greg Presley honored as Northville Volunteer of the Year
 - Seven Mile and Sheldon Roundabout first design presentation made to Council

 - March 6 is “Day of the Dude” with goal of raising \$25,000 for Fort Griswold replacement
 - Significant public comment on cease fire in Palestine at Council

 - Michigan Medicine back out of clinic at Hillside
