3. Program Report - Director Prevo

NYN wrapped up programing for the school year:

- Choosing Good Friends for ages 9-12 with 18 participants was held which focused on empowering participants with the skills to identify positive traits in friendships and navigate peer relationships with confidence.
- Kona Ice & Community NYN springtime event was held with over 75 participants.
- Teen Talk was held with five participants and Project Respect with four participants in May.
- Hillside Makers' Club and Meads Mill Peer-2-Peer completed their programs, with 43 and 55 participants, respectively.

Registration for CAMP Hillside/Meads Mill is at capacity for both sites and planning and logistics for the program continues.

NYN staff met with Northville High School counseling staff to discuss the potential of a pilot wellness program to be launched at the high school in the fall of 2024. Plans could include sessions on how to deal with stress and anxiety and the importance of self-care. Holding sessions on site during the school day (seminar) will make NYN programs more accessible to students.

NYN staff members are circling back with referrals from the year to make sure our youth are in a good place for the summer.
